

Reflection on the Baptism of the Lord: The Baptism of the Lord, celebrated each year at the conclusion of the Christmas season, invites profound reflection on the humility, identity, and mission of Jesus Christ. Though sinless, Jesus willingly was baptised by John the Baptist in the Jordan River, not for His own purification, but to sanctify the waters and to identify fully with humanity in its need for repentance and renewal. This pivotal moment marks the beginning of His public ministry and reveals the Holy Trinity—God the Father's voice from heaven declares, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased," while the Holy Spirit descends like a dove. Jesus' baptism underscores the importance of humility and obedience, as the divine Son enters into solidarity with the human journey. For believers, this feast is a call to renew their own baptismal promises, to remember their dignity as beloved children of God, and to live out their faith with purpose and compassion in the world.
