A Reflection on John 1:29–34: The Lamb of God and the Power of Recognition

In John 1:29–34, John the Baptist delivers a pivotal testimony, declaring Jesus as the “*Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world.*” This moment marks a turning point in the Gospel of John, where the Baptist’s role as a forerunner transitions to a profound acknowledgment of Jesus’ divine identity. John’s exclamation is rooted in both prophecy and revelation. By invoking the image of the lamb, he evokes the Old Testament sacrifices, particularly the Passover lamb, whose death spared Israel from bondage. In Christ, this symbolism reaches its fulfilment: Jesus becomes the ultimate, once-for-all sacrifice, embodying God’s redemptive love for all humanity.


